Part Two will include a presentation on the **electronic contact information database** used for reporting failed bacteriological samples and emergency situations.

Due to protocols with Alberta Health, Alberta Environment & Parks (AEP) is required to maintain a database for Contact information for all drinking water facilities that send samples to ProvLab. There have been other avenues to collect this information but none were able to maintain an accurate and current listing. As part of DWQ Electronic Reporting, AEP developed a Contact Details system that went live in June 2015. It was deemed that the most accurate and current Contact information must come from the facilities, and the Contact Details system provides the means to record that required information. AEP, under Provincial Programs, Drinking Water Branch, requires that this Contact Information be mandatory. This presentation will step through the updated Contact Details system and address processes for changing data for current users and obtaining access for new users.
