Travelling to various job sites may be required.

As a WT&WWT operator, you will be responsible for ensuring the safe and efficient operation of water treatment facilities, while working with a small team under supervision. This position includes working on a shift (10 days on/4 days off, Tuesday through to the following Thursday).

Working under the supervisor's guidance, you're responsible for conducting the daily operation and maintenance of the facility.

The main responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to:

- Operating and overseeing daily plant operations to ensure smooth functioning of water treatment processes.
- Conducting laboratory testing to monitor water quality and ensure compliance with regulatory standards.
- Assisting in preparing monthly and annual reports to document operational activities and performance.
- Maintaining and repairing distribution/collection systems through regular flushing and maintenance.
