We are currently accepting applications for Public Works Foreman. This part time, working foreman, reports to the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), provides leadership to all aspects of the public works department, including supervision of part time departmental staff, and is responsible for the safe and prudent operation, maintenance and replacement of Village assets and infrastructure.

Requirements:

- Completion of Grade 12 supplemented by technical courses related to the work plus some related experience working with water treatment systems; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

- > Possess and maintain a valid Class 5 AB driver's license.
