About the Role:

Wheatland Regional Corporation is seeking a permanent full time Certified Level III Water/Wastewater Operator or a Level II Operator who is looking to achieve their level III, to join our team in Standard Alberta. Accountable to the General Manager, this position requires an individual with effective organizational, analytical, communication/interpersonal, and mechanical skills, the ability and desire to work independently, exercise initiative and foster good working relationships and is highly motivated.

You will be responsible for conducting the daily operation and maintenance of our facilities.

The main responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to:

- Maintain water and sewer facilities
- Follow “Alberta Environment Code of Practice” and provide safe and potable drinking water
- Respond promptly and appropriately to alarms and situations that may occur such as low/high pressure alarms, high flow alarms, reservoir level alarms, power failures, etc.
- Analyze and interpret graphs and data from the SCADA system
- Monthly scheduled water meter reads, and meter changes
- Perform seasonal maintenance; hydrant flushing, valve exercising, weed whip pipeline manholes
- Perform daily random water grab samples and record daily check results
- Participate in rotating on call schedule

Required Qualifications:

- Certification: Must have Level 2 Water Treatment & Distribution and be working towards Level 3, Level 2 Wastewater Collection/Treatment;
- High School Diploma;
- SCADA System experience and computer competency in Microsoft Office programs;
- A valid Class 5 Alberta Motor Vehicle Operator’s License, with a driver’s abstract required.
- Must be willing to live within Wheatland County or any village or hamlet within the County for On-Call duties
